About the “Cross border Doctoral workshop”

The Cross border Doctoral workshop” objective is to prepare the participants for their **professional career outside Academia**. It is a multicultural, multidisciplinary and bilingual (French – English) workshop **held at Université de Lyon (FR)**, that brings together doctoral students from Université de Lyon (FR), University of Turin (IT), University of Brescia (IT), the Western Swiss Universities Conference-CUSO (CH) and the Istituto Italiano di Tecnologia di Genova-IIT (IT).

Selection criteria

- Be a doctoral student enrolled in the 3rd year of a PhD Programme of the University of Brescia, for A.Y. 2024/2025
- Being interested in pursuing a career outside Academia
- Showing strong motivations in participating to all the activities
- Having good language skills (English or French): proficiency certificates are not compulsory, but highly recommended

- Your concise CV (French or English or both indifferently, oriented to a non-academic career)
- Your motivation letter to take part to the Workshop. Please do indicate the language you want to work with (French, English or both indifferently)
- Authorization letter by the Supervisor

Selection process

A selection process will take place only if the number of applications is over 5.

In that case, a Board of Examiners will hold an oral assessment concerning the motivation and aptitude of candidates.

PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The processing of personal data provided by applicants and collected for the purposes identified in this Call takes place in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation 27.04.2016 n. 679 (General Data Protection Regulation, following: GDPR).
